



STAGE II DROUGHT WATER RESTRICTIONS



EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Due to continued extreme heat, dry conditions, and high water consumption, Bolivar Water Supply Corporation is implementing **Stage II** Water Conservation/Drought Restrictions.

These restrictions are necessary to help maintain adequate water supplies, protect system pressure, and ensure reliable service for all BWSC members.

OUTDOOR WATERING SCHEDULE

Outdoor irrigation using automatic sprinkler systems or hose-end sprinklers is permitted only on the designated watering days for your address.

ODD-NUMBERED ADDRESSES



**TUESDAY
& SATURDAY**

Examples: 101, 135, 247, 369, etc.



EVEN-NUMBERED ADDRESSES



**THURSDAY
& SUNDAY**

Examples: 102, 246, 358, 480, etc.



**WATERING PERMITTED ONLY
DURING THE FOLLOWING HOURS:**

12:00 MIDNIGHT – 7:00 AM

8:00 PM – 12:00 MIDNIGHT

HAND-WATERING & DRIP IRRIGATION

The following methods are permitted:



Hand-held hose
with a shutoff nozzle



Hand watering



Drip irrigation



Soaker hoses
(if authorized under the BWSC plan)

Members are encouraged to use these methods whenever possible to conserve water.

PLEASE HELP CONSERVE



Avoid unnecessary water use.



Repair leaks promptly.



Limit outdoor water consumption.



This is a temporary conservation measure brought on by extreme heat and unusually high demand. Your cooperation will help BWSC maintain adequate water supplies and system pressure for everyone.
