Dear Valued BWSC members,

Drought conditions continue to impact portions of Texas. With continued dry conditions and increasing water demands, public water systems may begin to experience strain on available water supplies. It is critical that we take the necessary steps now to prevent the loss of drinking water needed for basic health and safety services.

Effective immediately, we are implementing **Stage 1 of our Drought Contingency Plan.**

Stage 1 is intended to raise awareness and encourage voluntary conservation. Customers are requested to limit discretionary water use and utilize water more efficiently. Standard Stage 1 conservation measures include:

- Limiting outdoor watering to no more than twice per week, preferably during early morning or late evening hours
- Avoiding runoff and excessive irrigation
- Using a hose with a positive shutoff nozzle when washing vehicles
- Refraining from washing driveways, sidewalks, and other impervious surfaces
- Repairing leaks in plumbing, irrigation systems, and fixtures promptly
- Reducing overall indoor and outdoor water use wherever possible

Conservation at this stage is essential to avoid more severe restrictions in the future. If conditions worsen, additional stages with mandatory limitations will be implemented.

We cannot stress enough the importance of conserving water at this time. Every gallon saved helps protect our system and ensures continued service for essential needs across our community.

We appreciate your cooperation and commitment to preserving our shared water resources.
